National Science Foundation awards ceremony recognises scientists and researchers

The National Science Foundation (NSF) awards ceremony is set for Thursday, April 4, from 8.30 to 11.30 am, at the Education Ministry, Isurupaya, Battaramulla. Education Minister Dr Susil Premajayantha will attend.

The NSF is one of the top science and technology institutions in the nation, and advances science, technology, and innovation for socioeconomic development.

It annually hosts an award ceremony to recognise and award scientists and researchers for their contributions to the scientific arena and national development.

To honour Lankan research degree supervisors, 'Support Scheme for Supervision of Research Degrees (SUSRED) Awards' which was introduced to bolster the National Research System by adding more competent and trained researchers to a dynamic research environment, are also presented at the award ceremony.

The NSF releases an open call for applications each year. Supervisors of post-graduate degrees, MPhils and PHDs are welcome to apply for awards.

This year, 96 researchers including academics from 17 institutions and research centres around the nation will receive 42 awards. **(NA)**
